Francis Megerlin is full professor of health laws and systemics at the University of Strasbourg / EUCOR – The European Campus (a french-german-swiss cluster of universities), and senior fellow, Berkeley Center for Health Technology, university of California. He also physically lectures at the Institute of Political Studies in Paris, at the Université Internationale Abulcasis des Sciences de la Santé in Rabat, Morocco, whose he is member of the scientific council; at the ISCAE (Casablanca) & at the university of Algiers. He also gives online lectures in several universities in/outside the EU. He is a full member, Académie Nationale de Pharmacie, France.

Pr. Megerlin holds a PhD in International & Comparative Law (settlement of complex litigation & ADR laws) and a HDR in Pharmaceutical Sciences (health information systems). His teaching covers transversal topics, including health laws, economics, policy & trade governances. His current research focuses on the systemic impact of advanced health technologies, on innovative pricing and payment methods for health technologies and services, AI & data governance, and on the competitive transformation of complex organizations under constraints, for public and private decision support.

He has published over 120 papers in scientific and policy journals, chapters in books, etc. His activities include his roles as keynote-speaker for invited conferences, policy roundtables, national reforms and board meetings in Europe, North & South America, Africa and Asia. Pr Megerlin also plays the oboe and is an orchestra conductor.
