

Francis MEGERLIN, PhD, HDR is Full Professor, Health Laws and Systemics at the University of Strasbourg / EUCOR (*EUropäische Conföderation Ober Rhein - a french-german-swiss cluster of universities*). His teaching covers transversal topics, including health laws, economics, policy & global trade governances. He also lectures other EU and non-EU universities.

His current research focuses on the systemic impact of advanced health technologies, on innovative pricing and payment methods for health technologies and services, AI & data governance, for the competitive transformation of complex organizations.

Francis holds a PhD in International & Comparative Law (settlement of complex litigation & ADR laws) and a HDR in Pharmaceutical Sciences (health information systems for decision support). He is a full member, Académie Nationale de Pharmacie, France, and a senior fellow, Berkeley Center for Health Technology, university of California & member of the Scientific Council, Université Internationale Abulcasis des Sciences de la Santé, Rabat, Morocco.

He has published over 120 papers in scientific and policy journals, chapters in books, etc. His activities include his roles as keynote-speaker for invited conferences, policy roundtables, national reforms and board meetings in Europe, North & South America, Africa, MENA and Asia, for States, GO and NGOs. Francis also plays the oboe and is an orchestra conductor.
